Registration Fee	:	US\$250.00 per person to cover accommodation (twin sharing), food for the workshop duration, airport reception, transfer from airport to venue and back and materials.
Arrival and Departure	:	Participants are expected to arrive on 16 October, afternoon until evening and may depart on 20 October noon. It is highly encouraged to avoid arriving/ departing in the late hours and early morning in consideration of the airport reception/ local transportation team.
Airport Reception	:	Participants will be met by TGASC Scouts at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE) and will be transported to the venue. For easy recognition, it is expected that participants arrive in uniform or at least wear the scarf.
Travel Insurance	:	It is highly recommended to secure travel insurance in any regional/ international events. Please ensure to purchase travel insurance locally.
What to bring	:	Scout uniform or smart casual attire or Local traditional costume, personal clothings, personal medicines, etc.
Who can participate	:	Key Leaders at the District /State & National Level
Working Language	:	The working language of the workshop is English. Participants must be able to understand and take an active part in the discussions in English.

Weather:	:	Taiwan weather in October gets cooler and cooler, with the averagetemperature of around 21 - 27°C (70 - 81°F). There are some rains andshowers in October in Taiwan, and the most of rains fall in the northernarea including Taipei, Keelung and Yilan, and Taitung and Hualien in theeast and mountain areas. It is quite clear in the middle and southernplaces.
		With the start of the cold weather, light clothing still works and a lightsweater or coat. It is recommended to always carry a small umbrella
Currency	:	NTD is the official currency Credit cards are widely accepted throughout the Taiwan. It is highly recommended to change your money at the airport if you do not have credit card.
Electricity:	:	Taipei has the same electrical standard as the US and Canada: 110V,60Hz AC. Electrical sockets have two vertical slots.

Travel and Visa Arrangements	:	Granting VISA lies in the discretion of the Taiwan Embassy. BSG NHQ, is not responsible if VISA is rejected due to any reason/reasons thereof. Hence, no claim is admissible.
