Pioneering Project for Scouts Only:

Scouts will prepare Pioneering Projects i.e. one only. Adult Leaders can also help the Scouts in preparing pioneering Projects. Usefulness, correctness of knots and lashings, skill involved, cleanliness in building, Size of the Prepare Pioneering Project will be observed.

Collection of the materials for preparing Pioneering Project is the Primary responsibility of the state.

Rangoli for Guides only:

Guides will prepare Rangoli in the designated place, One only. One Patrol of Guides along with Unit Leader can be deputed for Rangoli Competition. Rangoli can be prepared with any materials and present their talent. Theme, Skill involved, Materials used, Size and design of art, authenticity will be observed. Date and Time of the competition will announce during the event.

Colour Party:

Each State Contingent will be allowed one Colour Party of Five members. They should be in Scout/Guide Uniform with white gloves and anklets.

Flag Bearer may wear leather carrier belt. Colour Party should be made up of 3 Scouts and 2 Guides or vice versa.

(For Formation & Ceremonial Dresses, "Drill & March Past" & APRO Part—I to be followed.

Food Plaza:

Cooking dishes and serving them to a person will be thrilling experience. People will know the special dishes of the State. One can also explain how to prepare your traditional dishes. A Chart of Ingredients may also be put up. Duration 2 hours.

Patriotic Dance Performances:

Patriotic songs are the medium to reveal our love and respect not only towards our nation but our own self also. Minimum number of participants is 16. No Adult leader will be allowed . adult leader may help by playing music and signing song for the dance.

: Folk Dance:

There will be a folk dance festivals. Scout and Guides may participate jointly.

Minimum number of participants is 16. No Adult leader will be allowed to participate in the folk dance but adult leader may help by playing music and signing song for the dance. Cultural Originality, Traditional Costumes, Uniformity, Make-up. Melodious Song with Traditional Local Music, Instruments & Presentation will be observed.

Ethnic Fashion Show:

An ethnic fashion show will be organized during the event. Each Contingent will depute a Scout and a Guide to show case cultural tradition of the respective state and walk on a ramp.

An Over-Night Hike for Scouts and Guides is planned. An opportunity to visit the local inhabitants, learn their culture & tradition, undertake community development service as a part of good turn and study the local Flora and Fauna as well.

Exhibition:

An Exhibition will be setup where participants will be able to display their exhibits: Exhibition may be any of the following:
