Safe from Harm	:	Participants must complete a "Safe from Harm" training and attach his certificate of completion with their registration form.
Weather	:	<ul> <li>During the gathering, the weather will be sunny during the day and cool at night, with expected temperatures ranging from 16°C to 24°C.</li> <li>Since the camping site is in an open area, participants must bring warm clothing, especially for night time (e.g., padded jackets and heavy trousers).</li> <li>Rain showers may occur during the gathering, so participants should bring a rain jacket.</li> </ul>
