

Human Rights are the basic rights we have been given to ensure our safety and protection. They are universal, which means they apply to everyone without exception, regardless of race, sex, gender, age or nationality.

A self-advocacy workshop, which can include role-playing activities, lectures, discussions, and so on, helps people understand the law and their human rights. They also help build communication skills, emotional resilience, and more.

- **Social Media Campaign:** We encourage everyone to participate by sharing messages, stories, and resources on social media platforms using the **hashtag #EmpoweringVoices**.
- **Participation:** We invite all staff to actively participate in these activities. Your involvement is crucial in promoting a culture of respect and understanding within our organization and the wider community.
