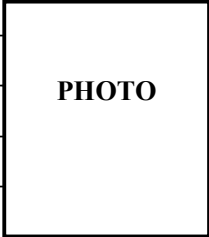

As you are aware, the Diamond Jubilee Jamboree of the Bharat Scouts and Guides is scheduled to be held at SIPCOT Industrial Park (SIPKOT Campus), Manapparai, Tiruchirappalli District (Trichy), Tamil Nadu, from **28th January to 3rd February 2025**. This event, themed "**Sashakt Yuva, Vikshit Bharat**" (Empowered Youth, Developed India), marks a significant milestone in our journey, and we are excited to provide an excited experience with adventure and fun-based activities for the Scouts and Guides participating in this historic event.

In preparation for the construction of the adventure and fun base activities, we require the support of the State Associations to depute competent **Rover Scouts or Young Unit Leaders**, aged between **15-45 years**, with **proficiency in knotting, lashings, pioneering projects, and carpentry**. These volunteers must be **physically fit and capable of undertaking strenuous work for approximately 12 hours a day**. They should be available from **20th December 2024 to 3rd February 2025** and will be considered NHQ staff during the Jamboree period.

By Road: The site is accessible via **National Highway 38**, connecting to major towns in Tamil Nadu.

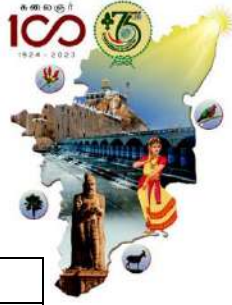

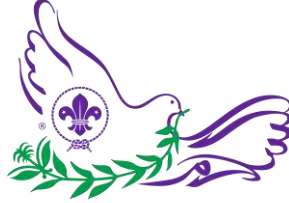

We are pleased to inform you that the Messenger of Peace initiative was launched and have attracted young people across the movement to undertake community service project and have contributed millions of service hours. The Bharat Scouts and Guides have embraced the initiative and have significantly created a ripples and visibility to the Movement.

Globally World Organisation of the Scout Movement (WOSM) has a tradition of awarding Messengers of Peace Hero Award for Scouts below 26 years for their outstanding work and impact created in the community since 2014 and on the same lines World Scout Bureau, Asia-Pacific Region also recognise with APR MOP Hero Award for the all outstanding work and impact created in the community by Scouts and Leaders.

To inspire and motivate young people, adult leaders and the State Associations as a whole in undertaking more community oriented activities and create impact of Scouting/Guiding in the community, The Bharat Scouts and Guides has decided to invite nominations for **MOP STAR Award** in 3 (Three) Categories as mentioned hereunder:

- 1. MOP Star Awards – For Young People (10 – 25 Years)**
- 2. MOP Star Inspirers Award – For Warranted Adult leaders above 25 years.**
- 3. MOP Star State Award – For State Associations of the BSG.**

The nominations will be an open call through Online Applications. Once shortlisted, the National Headquarters will seek endorsement from respective State Associations before declaring the winners for MOP Star Award-2023-24. **Candidate endorsed by the State Association only will be considered by the National Headquarters.**

The purpose of the award is to:

- ✓ Acknowledge and recognize grassroots Scouting/Guiding efforts and contributions to community service, the SDGs, and the creation as well as promotion of a culture of peace
- ✓ Recognize youth engagement and cooperation with community actors in the solution of local issues
- ✓ Raise awareness of the role of Scouting/Guiding in creating better communities



- ✓ Strengthen the sense of a global network of service among Scouts/Guides and community actors for Sustainable Development

Who is eligible to be a Messengers of Peace Star?

1. Registered member of the Bharat Scouts and Guides having valid BSG UID.
2. Must fall under any of the following Category
 - a. **MOP Star Awards – For Young People (10 – 25 Years)**
 - b. **MOP Star Inspirers Award – For Warranted Adult leaders above 25**
 - c. **MOP Star State Award – For State Associations**
3. Scouts/Guide/Rover/Ranger/Adult Leader who have made a significant contribution to the culture of peace or community development at the local or national level
4. Nominees can have completed their project either at their own or as part of a team
5. Nominees can be selected to represent an individual or on behalf of a group efforts.
6. Nominees must be endorsed by their respective State Association

MoP Stars will be selected based on the following criteria

- Projects and actions inspired by Messengers of Peace, the World Scout Environment Programme/ The Earth Tribe, Dialogue for Peace and any other regional or national Scout initiative and actions taken during Covid-19 pandemic
- Projects must have taken place in the last 24 months. Ongoing projects completed more than 12 months will also be considered.
- Service actions or projects must have had a demonstrable impact in the community
- Demonstrated participation of the Scout or Scout group in the development and implementation of the project or action
- The projects must have to be uploaded on scout.org

Note: The final decision on the award is made by a selection committee constituted by Chief National Commissioner and the decision of the committee is final in all respects. As it is an award, hence cannot be demanded or challenged.

The Messengers of Peace Star Award is a recognition system by the Bharat Scouts and Guides to recognise exceptional Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers and Adult Leaders (Volunteers & Professionals) for their outstanding work in creating a better India. The award acknowledges and recognises the extraordinary service of young people and their contributions towards community development, the promotion of dialogue and peace, and relief in times of need.

An invitation for nominations is now open for **Messengers of Peace Star Award-24**. Scouts/Guides, Rovers/rangers, Adult Leaders and States are invited to nominate exceptional grassroots Scout/Guide, Rover/Ranger and Adult Leaders to be recognised for their outstanding service to the local communities.
