The Director will identify the projects for the Intern's assignment upon receiving the applications from State Association/Individual or from Institutions.
Commencement	:	Any executive/intern should begin the assignment only after they have agreed to the guidelines and the conditions on the Programme.
Reports	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upon completion of the assignment, the executive/intern shall submit a brief summary report including an evaluation on the prescribed form, before departure from the base location. The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters will also send performance report of the interns to the sponsoring State Association/ Institution.
Location on assignment	:	Internship assignments will take place both at the NHQ Office and in the field as per the demand of the project.
Language requirement	:	The working language will be both Hindi and English. Therefore, Interns shall be fluent in spoken and written English/Hindi.
Type of Assignment	:	The work is desk based on site or field work. It will include project formulation, monitoring and/ or evaluation, research and preparation.



SUBJECT: INTRODUCTION OF BSG SMART ID CARD FOR MEMBERS OF BSG

Dear Members,

We are pleased to announce the launch of the BSG Smart ID Card as per the decision of the Executive Committee. Starting from 2025, the Smart ID Card will be mandatory for all BSG members participating in National and International events. This initiative aims to enhance efficiency, ensure data authenticity, and provide a seamless identification system for all members.

Key Features of the BSG Smart ID Card:

1. Verification: The card is linked to the registered data of the BSG UID on the OYMS portal and is also Aadhaar verified.
2. Cost and Specifications of Each ID Card includes:
 - RFID-enabled card
 - Aluminium card protector casing
 - ID card lanyard
 - Cost: Rs. 120 (inclusive of all components as mentioned above)

Procurement Process:

- Online Purchase:
 - Visit www.shop.bsgindia.org to order individual or bulk ID Cards by the School, District or State to order.
- Offline Purchase:
 - Contact supply@bsgindia.org for offline procurement for the State Association to fill the Excel format attached.

Application Process:

- **Step 1:** Register on the BSG Events Portal: www.bsgevents.in if already registered then just to follow step 2
- **Step 2:** Log in to your individual account.
- **Step 3:** Add the invoice number and date of purchase to "Apply for the ID Card" button and submit.

- The details and photo provided during registration on the BSG Events Portal will be used for generating the ID Card, eliminating the need for a separate application form.


For Individual or for Schools apart from participating in Diamond Jubilee Jamboree they can go through the regular process through online.

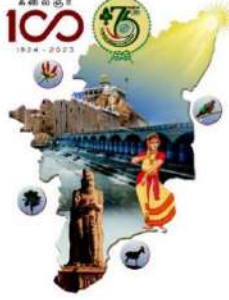
