Name of the Event	: 26th Australian Jamboree (AJ2025)
Date	: 06th to 15th January, 2025
Venue	: Maryborough Showgrounds and Equestrian Park, hosted by Scouts Queensland

	head. Scanned copy of the caution money & registration fee Rs. 25,000+5000 = 30,000/- deposit/pay-in-slip is to be send along with application form to authenticate the transfer.
Airfare & VISA	: Granting VISA lies in the discretion of the Australian Embassy. BSG NHQ, is not responsible if VISA is rejected due to any reason/reasons thereof. Hence, no claim is admissible. Regarding airfare & VISA it will be communicated once selection letter is issued. Approximately Rs. 90,000/- will cost on airfare & VISA charges (subject to actual during the time of booking)
