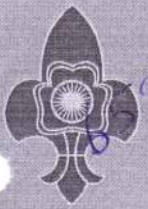


Suggested Programme and activities to observed the National Girl Child Day are furnished herewith:

OBJECTIVES OF CELEBRATING ROAD SAFETY WEEK 2024


1. Decrease road accident death, and injury cases by applying road safety measures.



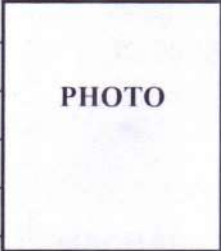


