




ANEMIA AWARENESS:

Anemia is a common condition characterized by a deficiency of red blood cells or haemoglobin in the blood, resulting in reduced oxygen supply to tissues and organs. This activity will delve into the causes, symptoms, and prevention strategies of anemia.

ANEMIA QUIZ

The Climate Leaders will participate or organise a Quiz Competition and enhance their knowledge through Test their knowledge with a fun and interactive quiz on anemia, covering its types, risk factors, and treatment options.

* ANEMIA AWARENESS WALK/RUN
The Climate Leaders will organize and participate in a charity walk or run to raise funds and awareness for anemia prevention and treatment initiatives. Provide educational materials and resources at the event to educate participants about the importance of maintaining healthy iron levels.





❖ HEALTHY EATING WORKSHOP:

The Climate Leaders will participate or organise a workshop on anemia Awareness with the help of local health Department and invite a healthcare professional to conduct an interactive workshop in which cover causes, symptoms, and prevention strategies on anemia and Learn about ironrich foods and how to incorporate them into your diet through a hands-on cooking workshop or a virtual demonstration.

❖ AWARENESS CAMPAIGN:

The Climate Leaders will create posters of social media content to raise awareness about anemia in their community, emphasizing the importance of regular blood tests and seeking medical advice.



HAND WASHING HYGIENE:

Hand washing is one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of infections and maintain good health. This activity will highlight the importance of proper hand washing techniques and hygiene practices.



❖ HAND WASHING RELAY:

The Climate leaders will participate or organize a relay race / Awareness Rally where Climate Leaders will demonstrate proper hand washing techniques and emphasizing the key steps and duration as per SUMAN K hand washing video.

* HAND WASHING CHALLENGE:

The Climate leaders will participate or organize a hand washing challenge in a Public Place (Rallway, Station /Schools /Market/Park etc) where participants learn proper hand washing techniques and compete in speed and accuracy as per SUMAN K. hand washing video Provide educational materials on the importance of hand washing in preventing the spread of diseases like anemia-related infections.

* HAND WASHING ART COMPETITION:

The Climate Leaders will Organize or participate an art competition where Climate Leaders create artwork highlighting the importance of hand washing in preventing anemia-related infections. And display the artwork in a public space or online gallery (By using Social Media) to raise awareness in the community.

❖ DIY HAND SANITIZER WORKSHOP:

The Climate Leaders will learn how to make their own hand sanitizer using simple ingredients and understand when and how to use it effectively.

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Climate Leaders will prepare or produce a creative video or poster campaign promoting the significance of hand washing hygiene, targeting social media platforms and community notice boards.





HEAT WAVE SAFETY:

Heat waves pose significant health risks, especially for vulnerable populations. This activity will educate participants on heat-related illnesses and strategies to stay safe during extreme heat events.

❖ HEAT WAVE SIMULATION:

Engage in a scenario-based activity where participants role-play various heat-related emergencies and learn how to respond effectively, including recognizing signs of heat exhaustion and heatstroke.

HYDRATION STATION

The Climate Leaders make a group and established a hydration station at a local Public Place or gathering, providing water and educational materials on the importance of staying hydrated during hot weather.

❖ HEAT WAVE PREPAREDNESS SEMINAR:

The Climate Leaders hold a seminar on heat wave preparedness, focusing on the risks associated with extreme heat and how to stay safe during heat waves. They offer practical tips such as staying hydrated, seeking shade, and recognizing signs of heat-related illnesses with the help of Health Department or healthcare professional.

→ HEAT WAVE RELIEF DRIVE

The Climate Leaders will organise or Coordinate are related vive to collect and distribute essential items such as bottled water, sunscreen, and cooling towels to vulnerable populations during heat waves.

***** COMMUNITY OUTREACH:

The Climate Leaders will organize and participate in a community outreach event where Climate Leaders will distribute informational Handmade and contact Health Department for pamphlets and conduct demonstrations on how to stay cool and protect one during heat waves.
