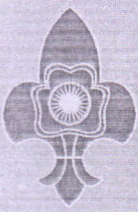



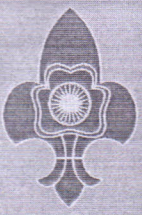

The competition is based on the theme "SDG - 13, SAY NO TO SINGLE USE PLASTIC". The competition aims to encourage our members to showcase their creativity and passion for the environment through short films.

As responsible citizens, we have a crucial role in protecting our environment and preserving it for future generations. The theme "SDG - 13, SAY NO TO SINGLE USE PLASTIC" is a call to action for all BSG members to showcase their ideas and initiatives to promote environmental conservation.

BSG members, who are above 13 years of age, individuals or Unit from anywhere in the country can participate in the competition. The competition is open to non-Scouts/Guides also, but they must collaborate with a Scout/ Guide unit/group to complete the project.

Guidelines for the competition are as follows:

1. The film should be within 5 - 7 minutes.
2. The films can be in any language but must have English/Hindi subtitles.
3. The film should be based on the theme, original and should not violate any copyright laws.
4. The film should be submitted in mp4 format through the Google Drive link.
5. The film should have a title, and the name(s) of the creator(s) must be mentioned in the submission form.

The entries will be judged on the basis of creativity, originality, content, technical aspects and the message conveyed by the film. Any soundtrack or music used for the production of the film must be royalty-free or with paid royalty rights or from original authorship.

The top three winners will be awarded cash prizes of Rs. 5000/-, Rs. 3000/-, and Rs. 2000/- respectively along with certificates and the film will be shared through BSG social media.

The deadline for submission of entries is 31st December 2023. All films should be submitted through an online Google form only. Please attach the Google Drive Open link in Google Form of your video, along with a short biography of the filmmaker, as well as a brief synopsis of your film (not more than 100 words) at the time of submission before **31st December 2023.**



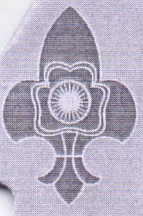

हम भारत स्काउट्स एवं गाइड्स के सभी सदस्यों को बीएसजी लघु फिल्म निर्माण प्रतियोगिता में भाग लेने के लिए आमंत्रित कर रहे हैं। प्रतियोगिता "एसडीजी-13, प्लास्टिक के एकल उपयोग को न कहें" विषय पर आधारित है। प्रतियोगिता का उद्देश्य हमारे सदस्यों को लघु फिल्मों के माध्यम से पर्यावरण के प्रति अपनी रचनात्मकता एवं उत्साह दिखाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करना है।

एक जिम्मेदार नागरिक होने के कारण, हमें पर्यावरण की रक्षा करने एवं इसे भावी पीढ़ियों के लिए संरक्षित करने में हमारी महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका है। विषय "एसडीजी-13, एकल उपयोग प्लास्टिक को ना कहें" सभी बीएसजी सदस्यों के लिए पर्यावरण संरक्षण को बढ़ावा देने के लिए अपने विचारों और पहलों को प्रदर्शित करने के लिए कार्यवाही का आह्वान करें।

बीएसजी सदस्य, व्यक्ति या इकाई प्रतियोगिता में देश में कहीं से भी 13 वर्ष से अधिक आयु के भाग ले सकते हैं। प्रतियोगिता गैर-स्काउट्स/गाइड्स के लिए भी खुली है, लेकिन उन्हें परियोजना को पूर्ण करने के लिए स्काउट/गाइड इकाई/समूह के साथ सहयोग करना होगा।

प्रतियोगिता के लिए दिशानिर्देश इस प्रकार हैं:

1. फिल्म 5 से 7 मिनट के अंदर की होनी होगी।
2. फिल्में किसी भी भाषा में हो सकती हैं लेकिन उनका उपशीर्षक अंग्रेजी/हिन्दी में होना होगा।

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

Amateur Radio is a community of people who use Radio transmitters and receivers to communicate with other Amateur Radio operators. The actions that amateur radio operators do with their radios are as diverse as the people themselves.

Amateur Radio operators are often called HAM Radio Operators or simply "HAM". Amateur (HAM) Radio is both a hobby and a service. It is an activity of self-learning, inter-communication and technical investigation carried out by duly authorized persons (i.e. Amateur Radio Operators) for a personal aim and without pecuniary interest. There are over 50 lakh people all over the world who pursue this activity in their free time. In India, we have around 20,000 Amateur Radio Operators.

Amateur Radio Operators must qualify for an examination conducted by the Ministry of Communication, Government of India and obtain a license for operation/ processing a Radio Station.

Amateur Radio Operators in their free time use their radio stations and conduct two-way communications and exchange, cultural, personal, and technical information with other amateurs not only within India but all over the world. Two-way communications using Radio Transmitters, receivers, and antennae can be either through voice, Morse Code, Digital (Video and Data), or Satellite.


