Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the World Scout Jamboree is a major international event organised by WOSM held once in every four years. The Jamboree provides a unique opportunity for young people to learn from one another, develop leadership skills, and engage in outdoor activities while embracing the Scouting principles of community service, personal growth, and environmental stewardship. In 2027, Poland will host the World Scout Jamboree for the first time, in the city of Gdańsk, in Pomorskie Region.

Date of Arrival	:	International Service Team (IST) & CMT	27 th July, 2027

Jamboree Fee	:	Jamboree Registration Fee 1600 PLN i.e. INR 38,000/- (Approximately) inclusive of CA & bank transfer charges. The charges may exceed if registration fee is not received within the given

Participants Fee Covers:

1. All campsite fees from the day of arrival on 29 July to the departure on 09th August, 2027 including relevant transportation for the programme activities.
2. Breakfasts, packed lunches and dinners for the duration of the Jamboree, from dinner on 29 July to breakfast on 09 August 2027.
3. From of the specified Jamboree Official entry point (Airport) in Poland and at the end of the jamboree transport from the site to a specific Jamboree official exit point.
4. Joint Unit equipment (i.e., Cooking tent and equipment). **No personal equipment will be provided i.e, tents, Cots, Sleeping bags etc.**
5. Medical care in case of illness (excluding pre-existing conditions) or accidents, including minor surgery or treatment, if necessary, for the duration of the Jamboree medications and any expenses related to specialized care or hospitalization are **NOT** included in the Jamboree fee.
6. A Jamboree participation kit, including an official Jamboree Scarf and badge.

IST/CMT Fee Covers:

1. All campsite fee from the day of arrival on 27 July 2027 to the departure on 10 August 2027.
2. Briefing and training including role-specific training before the arrival of participants.
3. Breakfasts, packed lunches and dinners for the duration of the Jamboree from dinner of 27 July to breakfast (with packed lunch) on 10 August 2027.
4. Transport from one of the specified Jamboree entry points (Airport) and at the end of the Jamboree transport from the Jamboree site to a specified Jamboree exit point (Airport).

Weather & Climate	:	Wyspa Sobieszewska has a warm temperate climate, moderated by the proximity of the sea. During July and August, the daily temperature averages 17°C, with an average high of 21°C and humidity of 55%. There is moderate rainfall, with an average of seven days of precipitation monthly during the summer.
Entry Points of Jamboree	:	Official Entry Points: Gdańsk Lech Wałęsa International Airport (GDN), Gdańsk Główny railway station, Gdańsk ferry terminal, Gdynia ferry terminal, and the bus parking in Gdańsk at the AmberExpo/Polsat Plus Arena.
Safe From Harm	:	The Safety of all participants is the highest priority and all adult participants will be required to take Safe from Harm training prior to attending the Jamboree. The Jamboree will comply with WOSM standards for Safe from Harm.
Pre-Existing Conditions	:	Those with pre-existing medical conditions should make special arrangements so as to be able to pay for any treatment related to such conditions.
Travel Insurance	:	It is recommended that all the members should obtain appropriate insurance cover, such as a travel insurance for such as a travel, insurance for the period prior to arrival at the start of the 26 th World Scout Jamboree and until the finish of the event in addition to the medical insurance.
Travel and VISA arrangements	:	Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements. Granting VISA lies in the discretion of the Poland Embassy. BSG NHQ, is not responsible if VISA is rejected due to any reason/reasons thereof. Hence, no claim is admissible if travelling in a group.

The Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree is a major Scouting event designed for young people once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to participate in a Regional Scout Jamboree on an international level.
